

THE GOTHENBURG COMBO THOMAS HANSY GITARR DAVID HANSSON GITARR

The Gothenburg Combo is one of Sweden's finest and most original contemporary musical acts. Their combination of showmanship, breathtaking ensemble-playing, highly innovative way of using the Guitars, warm sense of humor and deeply soulful musical performances have made their concerts unique in the contemporary music world today. 15 years of intense touring has made their performances amazingly tight and dynamic.

In 2004 TheGothenburgCombo won the first prize and the audiences's prize in "13eme Concours Internationale de Guitare en Duo" in Montelimar, France, one of the world's most prestigious Guitar competitions. Since then they have toured extensively and conquered the audiences and the critics hearts on numerous tours in Asia, North America, South America and Europe.

The breakthrough album "Soundscapes" (2007), featuring minimalist guitar music by Steve Reich, was released when the composer received the Polar Music Prize and The Gothenburg Combo also appeared at the award ceremony. "Sketches of the World" (2010) received rave reviews and was named the year's most important classic album in Dagens Nyheter. Their latest CD, Guitarscapes (2014), won the prize for the "best Experimental album of the year 2014" at the Swedish Independent Music Awards.
